#### LOVE IN WAR

The even darker side of conflict

Exit Art's latest exhibition, **Love/War/Sex**, features nine international artists who make us look at the unthinkable – the connections between longing, violence, and the “business of war in all its sexual manifestations” –through video, paintings, sculpture, and actual weaponry. The collection includes Jakob Boeskov's disturbing *War Wizard* (a video in which soldiers haunt a boy's dream with sex and violence), Guerra de la Paz's intimate *The Kiss* (a photograph of toy Army men holding each other), and Francesco Simeti's *Watching the War* (in which images of the war in

Afghanistan are juxtaposed onto pictures of keg parties and American families). It's not for the timid, but it'll definitely get you thinking about how scarily carnal we can be. *From noon to 8, through January 26, Exit Art, 475 Tenth Avenue, 212-966-7745, \$5 suggested donation.*
